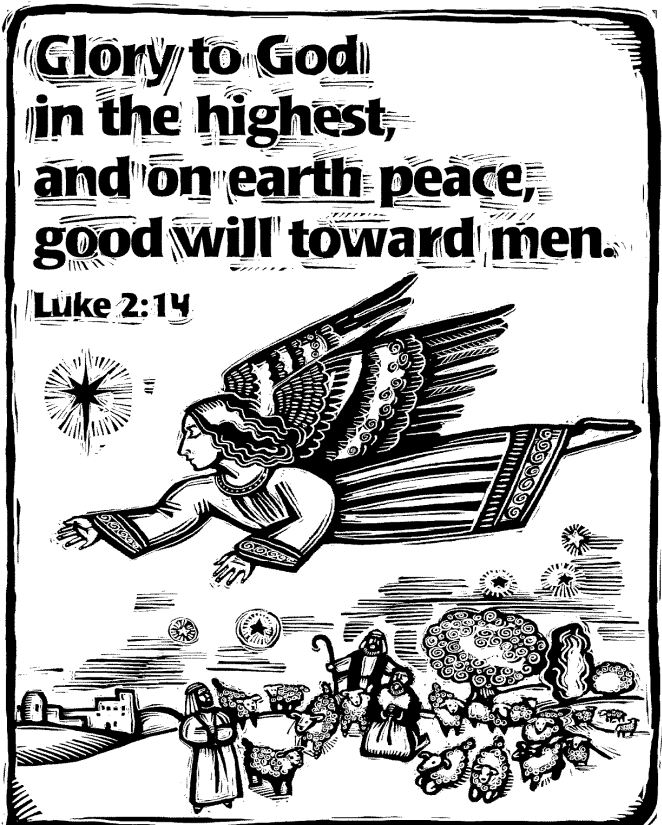
For all families: that love and forgiveness of Our Lord will be in manifest in their relationships with each other; we pray to the Lord.

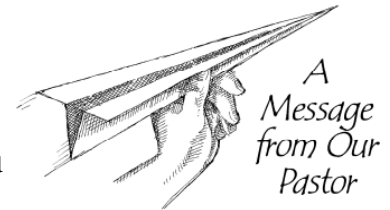


News and Events
